We are able to provide several scholarships of \$5,000 each summer to help students take advantage of and enable them to participate in a first time internship opportunity that is unpaid or provides a limited stipend.

The scholarships are designed for students who ordinarily would not be able to partake in an internship opportunity without the assistance of the scholarship funds.

Preference will be given to students who seek internships that are in the non-profit, humanitarian, scientific research (non-profit) or government sectors.
